

School Bus Riding Rules

Palm Beach Maritime Academy & High School

- 1. Obey the Bus Driver-** Obey the driver's directives at all times.
- 2. Respect-** Treat the bus driver and other riders with respect and courtesy.
- 3. Distractions-** Do not distract the driver. Unnecessary conversations with the driver are prohibited.
- 4. School Bus Conduct-** Classroom conduct is required on the school bus. Speak quietly. Stay seated at all times.
- 5. Bus Crossing-** Cross roadway 12 feet in front of the bus. Wait for the driver's signal to cross, board, or exit.
- 6. Assigned Bus-** Ride your assigned bus only.
- 7. Defacing/Graffiti-** Students shall not damage the bus or the seats.
- 8. Bus Stop-** Use the assigned bus stop only. Be at assigned bus stop at least 5 minutes before to pick-up time.
- 9. Bus Stop Safety-** Never stand in the roadway while waiting for the bus.
- 10. Interior Bus Safety-** Stay in assigned seat and wear seatbelts at all times.
- 11. Exterior Bus Safety-** Keep arms, hands, and head inside the bus at all times. Move away from the bus upon exiting and stay out of the danger zone.
- 12. Prohibited Bus Items-** Only items allowed in school are allowed on the bus.
- 13. Eating Prohibited-** Eating, drinking, smoking, vaping, alcohol and drugs are not permitted.
